Aircraft WiFi

There are several types of WiFi aboard corporate aircraft. Some aircraft equipment services domestic WiFi while others service WiFi internationally. However, there are some remote areas of the world in which the international service is unpredictable.

When chartering an aircraft, WiFi usage may be included in the cost of the trip, commonly charged at a defined rate. The most common form is by megabyte usage, ranging from \$ 7.99 - \$ 14.99 per megabyte (MB). We also see it measured by minutes.
